

The "Memorandum of Cooperation for the Promotion of Environmental Sustainability aimed at the Implementation of Best Practices in the Reclamation Sector" was signed this morning by the Extraordinary Commissioner for the Reclamation of Illegal Landfills, Giuseppe Vadalà, and the CEO of Sogin, Emanuele Fontani.

The aim of the memorandum is to promote collaboration as to the reclamation of illegal landfills in Italy to ensure the protection of the environment, the preservation of the land and the safeguarding of communities.
